Adaptive Pedal



Every child needs a chance to learn how to ride a bike.

The *SureFoot* has been designed to help children or adults alike who have a twisted foot condition. Quite often for children who use walkers cycling is the only time their legs experience a full range movement. This exercise is important for natural muscular development in the legs and torso.

The *SureFoot* has allowed for the best possible way for them to be able to get onto the bike or trike. Also, in case of a fall, it will release their foot so they are not trapped.



The pedal adapter has been designed to fit over any bike pedal. The plate itself allows for a range of sizes and shoe shapes. It will approx. fit a child's shoe size of 8 and can go up to an adult's size 10.



Children with cerebral palsy quite often have these foot orientation conditions, in which case if nothing is done to make the foot captive to a regular bicycle pedal, the child may not ever be able to experience the joys of riding conventional bikes or trikes.

This may become very important in the event that as an adult this person is unable for whatever reason to drive or use public transportation.

Having some form of recreational mobility as well as a form of transportation independent of our public systems can make a great deal of difference in an otherwise restricted life .
